

THE THOMAS PELLET HOUSE


An exquisite historic treasure, the Thomas Pellet House 5-7-13-15 Lexington Road, ca. 1673, located in the heart of Concord overlooking Monument Square.

THE PROPERTY OFFERS 9 BEDROOMS, 4.5
BATHS, 6 FIREPLACES WITHIN ITS FOUR
INDEPENDENT UNITS, EACH WITH PRIVATE
ENTRANCES. IN-UNIT LAUNDRY IN UNIT 5, 7
AND 13. IN ADDITION, 3 COURTYARDS AND
OFF-STREET TANDEM PARKING FOR 2
VEHICLES.

THE IMPECCABLY-MAINTAINED MAIN HOME IS A 3-STORY, 4-BEDROOM FEATURING MODERN CHERRY CABINETS, SOAPSTONE COUNTERTOPS, BEAMED SOFFITS. FORMAL LIVING AND DINING ROOMS WITH WELL-PRESERVED PERIOD DETAIL INCLUDING A BUILT-IN CHINA CABINET, BOOKCASES, DECORATIVE TRIMMED PANELING. WIDE-PLANK PINE FLOORS THROUGHOUT.

The northeast addition originally built in the early 1900's, served as a meeting hall for the Daughters of the American Revolution. It now offers two additional units: a large 2-bedroom dwelling (currently vacant as the main home) and a studio - (tenant-





occupied). The northwest 2-story, 2-bedroom "dollhouse" offers additional rental income - (also tenant-occupied).



This fine historic estate is a rarely available, truly remarkable asset with value-add potential for a sophisticated investor's portfolio or the passive income-oriented owner-occupant. One of the oldest residences in Massachusetts, it has served as a home for many families, businesses, and organizations for almost 350 years.


CONCORD — If you've been to George Washington's Mount Vernon mansion, the peach Georgian Colonial that over-

looks this town's common may look oddly familiar.

When the Revolutionary War general went to check out the house, which was beused a tea room in the house to help raise money for the organization. Today, the 4,342-square-foot house, portions of which date to 1673, is for sale for \$1,299,000. It consists of a main house

and three apartments in wings that were added in 1728 and 1929. There are six working fireplaces and nine bedrooms. The house was





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
